Eco Corner –

Do a Bee Walk: <http://beewalk.org.uk>

BeeWalk is a national recording scheme run by the Bumblebee Conservation Trust to collect data to monitor the abundance of bumblebees on transects across Britain. This data collection is impossible without volunteers, who identify and count the bumblebees they see on a monthly walk (a fixed route of around 1 to 2 km - you choose) from March to October.

The information collected is integral to monitoring how bumblebee populations change through time. It also allows detection of early warning signs of population decline, as well as monitoring of bumblebee population changes in response to changes in land-use and climate change.

Anyone can become a BeeWalker – all you need is some basic identification knowledge and a spare few hours or so every month to walk your transect and submit your sightings to the website.
